Therefore, the violation that is the subject of the complaint must be viewable from public rights of-way, from the Complainant's property, or from the property of a neighbor that is participating in the investigation. In instances where Board investigations are limited Complainants will be referred to the appropriate local, county, or state authorities for further action.
Submission of a complaint does not guarantee that the Board/ACC will take action. Should the Board determine that a Complaint is valid, it may begin enforcement proceedings. The Complainant must understand that remedial action available to the HOA may be affected by local, state and federal law. For this reason, the investigation may take several months and the result may not satisfy the Complainant completely.
